Research from the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) and the Campaign for Female Education (CAMFED) shows that many senior high school girls lack exposure to diverse career opportunities and the essential skills needed to succeed in rapidly changing sectors, leaving them uncertain about how to contribute to their communities or the economy.

The Girls Only Initiative addresses this gap by empowering girls with the skills, knowledge, and confidence to explore opportunities across various sectors of influence. The initiative fosters creativity, critical thinking, and a growth-focused mindset. This is achieved through workshops and exposure to female leaders and role models.

It prepares girls to lead and innovate in their communities. This equips them to contribute meaningfully and thrive in key industries.
